North Lincs Classic Motorcycle Club 2022 Championship Rules

There are several changes to the championship rules from previous years, please read and make yourself aware of the rules.

- There will be separate championships for both classic and modern bikes for each route. Easy, Clubman, 50/50 and Expert.
- To receive an award a rider must have scored points in a minimum of 6 of the 12 rounds in the same class, scoring points in multiple classes does not count.
- The final championship points will be worked out after dropping the riders 2 lowest scores. If a rider competes in every round then the 2 worst results will be dropped, if someone misses a couple of rounds due to not being able to enter for whatever reason, holidays, covid isolation etc then the 2 rounds not entered will be not counted.
- Junior riders under 16, who ride on the easy route will have a separate championship, this will follow the same rules as the adult championship. Riders under 16 who choose to ride on routes other than the white route will compete against the adult riders.
- The top 10 riders in each route will score championship points, 10 points for first place down to 1 point for tenth place.
- The top four riders in each championship will receive a trophy, these will be presented at the following years 2-Day Trial. In future there will not be trophies given to the winners of each individual event.
- If the trials can not go ahead due to coronavirus lockdowns or some riders cannot enter a trial due to local lockdowns but the trial still goes ahead then there will be no championship points awarded for that round.
